Clinical social work means the application by persons trained in social work, of established principles of psycho-social development, behavior, psychopathology, unconscious motivation, interpersonal relationships and environmental stress to the evaluation, assessment, diagnosis and treatment of bio-psycho-social dysfunction, disability and impairment, including mental, emotional behavior, developmental and addictive disorders, of individuals, couples, families or groups.
